



This money has been set aside for future needs and is not being used for ordinary expenses such as salaries and utilities. Our Increased Offertory Appeal was well received and helped up keep Sunday Collections on budget for the year. Unfortunately, our investments did not fair well, and with the increased cost of everything, we ended the year in a deficit.


