MISSION APPEAL: Next weekend, **October 21/22** we welcome Fr. John Bosco Mujuni who will speak at all the masses about supporting his home mission Church in the Archdiocese of Mbarara, Uganda, East Africa.

Fr. John Bosco will share the needs of his home mission church that is currently under construction. The new church was necessitated by an increase in the number of Christians in his home area. The old Church that was used since 1983 is very small to accommodate the number of Church participants. It was also constructed with poor materials that cannot make it last longer. The Church under construction has been roofed. The next phase is of completion, which entails: Stained glass windows, internal and external finishing, electric wiring and plumbing; estimated at \$70,000. Any amount you can donate will be highly appreciated.

Currently Fr. John Bosco is one of the African priests serving in our Diocese of Peoria at St. Patrick Parish, Dwight and St. Paul Parish, Odell. As a way of appreciating the services rendered by the priests from Africa and other mission lands, the Diocese of Peoria encourages each parish to have a missionary visit arranged, in order to support some churches in the mission lands.

Fr. John Bosco will have envelopes available where you can put your donation. If you will not be at Mass, you can send your donation by any other envelope of your choice, and mark your donation as Mission appeal. Please let us welcome Fr. John Bosco and be as generous as we can.
